#### Glenn E. L. Kjellberg

Glenn E. L. Kjellberg was born May 28, 1912, in Green Bay, Wisconsin, to Evert George and Anna (Swanson) Kjellberg. He grew up in Escanaba and married Ruth Forsberg in Chicago, Illinois, on March 23, 1935. He was ordained an elder in 1939 and served churches in Minnesota until his transfer to the Detroit Conference in 1945, where he served the following churches: Gladstone, Negaunee, Bay City: Madison Avenue, Detroit: Calvary, Detroit: Redford (Calvary), and

Garden City. He retired in 1976. He believed that with the right tools, enough time, some righteous indignation, and a lot of determination, household appliances, buildings, and institutions peoples' lives and perhaps even the world could be mended and made whole. He acted on that belief, not just with lip service but with his life and with his love.

He died at the Chelsea Retirement Community November 16, 1993. He is survived by his wife; sons, David (Jean) of Standish and Thomas (Penny) of New York; daughters, Nancy Cooper of Minneapolis, Minnesota, and Sally (Mark) Riddles of Fairfax, Virginia; 11 grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.

Cecil Lutey, was a retired part-time supply pastor and had served in the Marquette District. His three loves were god, People, and flowers. He dedicated his life to these three loves. Don A. Morris was born June 3, 1903, in Essex, Missouri, to William T. and Lou Ella (Gates) Morris. He married Edna P. From 1930-34, he served at Wesley Chapel Methodist Church, receiving his deacon and elder orders while pastor there.
