CHESTER W. LOUGHLIN

July 29, 1888 - April 4, 1979

Chester Willet Loughlin was born July 29, 1888 at Arlington Heights, Illinois, son of Willet Hall Loughlin, M.D. and Mrs. Anna Walters Loughlin. In August 1902 he entered the employ of the First National Bank of Chicago. During his employment there he studied accounting and also received the diploma of the Thicago Correspondence School of Law and the American Bankers Association for courses in business law and banking and finances. In 1918 he was employed as Promotion Secretary by the Epworth League of the Methodist Episcopal Church. His service there was interrupted by Army service (May 6 to November 1918) and continued until December 1919. On January 1, 1920 he became pastor of the Methodist Episcopal Church at Thornton, Iowa. In October 1920 he was admitted on trial by the Northern Iowa Conference and in October 1922 was admitted to full membership, ordained Deacon and appointed to attend school at Carrett Biblical Institute, Evanston, Illinois, being graduated and ordained Elder in 1924 and transferred to the Rock River Annual Conference in October 1926. In 1928 he was elected Treasurer of the Conference and after serving as pastor of several churches, in 1938 was appointed Comptroller and Business Manager of the Board of Education of the Methodist Episcopal Church. In 1940 he was elected Associate Treasurer and in 1944 Treasurer of the Board of Education of The Methodist Church at Nashville, Tennessee, serving in that capacity until his retirement July 31, 1958.

On September 4, 1925 he was married to Miss Edith May Morrission, who died August 25, 1926. On July 19, 1932 he was married to Miss Alice Carolyn Pierce of Evanston, Illinois who died on May 11, 1952. Their daughter Alice Eleanor (Mrs. John B. Ackley), her husband and five children of Decatur, Alabama survive. On November 13, 1972 he was married to Mrs. Viola I. Tiedemann, a fellow resident at Sun-N-Fun Trailer Village, Fort Myers,

He was awarded a degree of L.L.D. by Bethune-Cookman College, Daytona Beach, Florida "in recognition of his services to Negro Education." During his tenure as Treasurer of the Board of Education of The Methodist Church he was responsible for consolidation of the accounts of the Educational Branch's merger by the unification of the Methodist Episcopal Church, the Methodist Episcopal Church South and the Methodist Protestant Church. He arranged the financing of the Office Building erected by the Board in Nashville, Tennessee and took the lead in establishing the Pension Plan of the Board. In Florida he helped pastors of the Tice Methodist Church and the Olga-Fort Myers Shores United Methodist Church, often acting as an unofficial assistant pastor.

Six weeks before his death he moved to Decatur, Alabama. This memoir, other than this last paragraph, was written by Chester Loughlin, less than four days before his death.
