John Juergen Rasmussen, Jr.

The Reverend John Juergen Rasmussen, Jr. was born on September 5, 1934 in Bunkie, Louisiana to Mrs. Elise Louise Leinhardt Rasmussen and Reverend John J. Rasmussen, Sr. He graduated from C.E. Byrd High School in Shreveport, Louisiana, Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas and the Perkins School of Theology at SMU. He was pastor of 15 churches in three conferences including the North Texas, Louisiana and Southwest Texas Conferences during his ministry. He died at his home in San Antonio, Texas September 10, 1999.

John not only served churches in three different conferences but also had a special talent in television ministry with First Church Dallas, Texas and First Church, Shreveport, La. He was a chaplain with the police departments in New Orleans and Shreveport, La., as well as with Methodist Hospital in San Antonio. He was the organizing pastor of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Mesquite, Texas. Following his retirement from full time ministry in 1995, he continued to live in San Antonio and share his talents with the public as a greeter at Wal-Mart until the time of his death.
