our educational institutions and the vital importance of our young people securing their higher education in our Christian schools.

We recommend that our apportionment for the current expenses of Western Union College be an amount equal to 45 cents per member.

We recommend that J. C. Plagge be the financial agent of the College fund and that he receive \$25.00 for the year.

The Auditing Committee of the financial agents report shall be F. A. Hoerner and G. S. Smith.

We nominate J. Hoerner, H. H. Thoren and J. C. Plagge as the Endowment Fund Committee.

We nominate J. W. Davis for examiner in Apologetics and Theism, H. H. Thoren in Psychology, E. K. Hershey in Ethics and Logic, J. H. Keagle in Systematic Theology and General History, L. C. Schmidt in Church history, Annals and History of Christian Doctrine, C. G. Unangst in Homiletics, Bible and Social Message, F. A. Hoerner in Hermeneutics, Discipline and Civics, J. W. Michael in Sermon Outline, Written Sermon and Rhetoric.

We recommend that \$50.00 be appropriated from the conference treasury for the General Board of Education and sent to Dr. A. E. Gobble, Myerstown, Pennsylvania.

In view of the fact that our college trustees visit our college annually and that we also have college representatives come to us each year, we see no need of a visiting delegate to that institution, but recommend that F. K. Mertz, or some other student representative who has attended that institution and has the spirit of Western Union College, be invited to visit each camp meeting this fall; expenses of same to be paid by the conference if necessary.

Whereas, In the providence of God there has been taken out of our midst by death one of our ablest preachers and leaders, our beloved brother Rev. B. R. Schultze, who through 29 years of unbroken service supported with unswerving loyalty our doctrines and institutions, be it
