9. How long have you entertained this conviction? *Since eighteen years of age.*
10. Do you desire and intend to make this your life work, and are you willing to labor in any field? *I desire to be guided by Providence as to time and place.*
11. To what extent are you acquainted with the work of the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society? *I have a general idea of the work the society is trying to do.*
12. Have you any views which would prevent your cordial co-operation with the missionaries of the Methodist Episcopal Church? *No.*
13. Would you be willing to give up any personal habit which might grieve your fellow missionaries and lessen the influence of your example over the native Christians? *Yes.*
14. Are you a total abstainer from all forms of alcoholic beverages and from opium, cocaine and other narcotics? *Yes*
15. What is the condition of your health? (Answer questions in Form Two and procure testimony of a competent physician according to Form Three.)
16. Outline the character and extent of your education.
