VERE W. ABBEY

The Rev. Vere W. Abbey has been a missionary of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Rangoon, Burma, since 1920. He has served as pastor of the Epworth Memorial Church in Rangoon and as Superintendent of the English district of the Burma Conference.

Mr. Abbey was born in Carbondale, Pennsylvania and educated in the Carbondale High School and in Taylor University. He was licensed to preach at the age of 21 and two years later joined the Dakota Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church. He taught high school in Minnesota for one year and was pastor of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Coleman, South Dakota, for three years prior to his appointment as a missionary in Burma.
