

**AUSTIN, LAURA F.**

Laura F. Austin - Credentials were approved by the General Executive Committee of the fall of 1904, and appointment was designated for India. The Board of Foreign Missions withheld approval at first on the score of possible ill health in a tropic clime, but withdrew objection later on learning that the physician's statement was probably overcautious and that Mrs. (Bishop) Warne had approved the appointment.

Miss Austin sailed for India in the Autumn of 1905, under appointment to Bombay Conference, for work in Gujarat. She was the first Standard Bearer missionary of the Columbia River Branch.

Laura Austin, '14, July 2, 1962, in "Wesley Gardens," a retirement home near Tacoma, Wash. She attended high school in Portland and prepared for mission service in New York. She earned her AB degree in Willamette University after her first term of service in India. She spent a total of 45 years in Mission service in Bombay State, Western India. Her most notable work was in helping Dr. Frank Laubach prepare charts for teaching adults to read Gujarati, the local language. She then used these charts for training many illiterate adults, in translating hymns and stories from English into their language and in starting and editing for many years a magazine for Gujarati children, the Balvadi or "Children's Garden."

Laura Faye Austin

Miss Laura Faye Austin, age 82, retired missionary, passed away at Wesley Gardens, Des Moines, Washington, July 2, 1962.

Born in Cedar Mills, Minnesota, January 3, 1880, she attended Folts Mission Institute, University of Oregon, received her B.A. degree from Willamette University. Prior to her serving as a missionary in India she taught for four and a half years in public schools in Portland, Oregon.

Miss Austin sailed for India in 1905. Her first appointment was in Baroda for language study and village work. During subsequent years she served in Godhra, Bombay and Nadiad, in the field of education and evangelism. She retired in 1951, and in 1957 she became a resident of Wesley Gardens, Des Moines, Washington.

Miss Austin will long be remembered for her dedicated spirit and radiant faith.
